# Water Everywhere

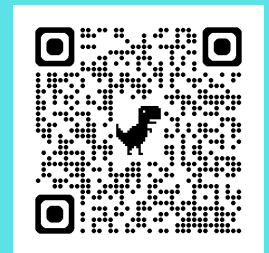
